It is a great pleasure to welcome you to the FIRST TC Seoul.






How to Get to the Hotel – Taxi

Total distance about 62km Price for taxi : approximately \$50(USD), ₩50,000(KRW) How to Get to the Hotel – Airport Limousine No. 6011

Bus Stop : 5B & 12A (1<sup>st</sup> floor of Airport Terminal)

The bus runs every 20-30 minutes from Incheon International Airport and It will take approximately 70 minutes to Anguk Station

Price for the limousine : approximately \$15(USD), ₩16,000(KRW)
